Next Friday is a non uniform day in return for bringing in donations for the summer fair.

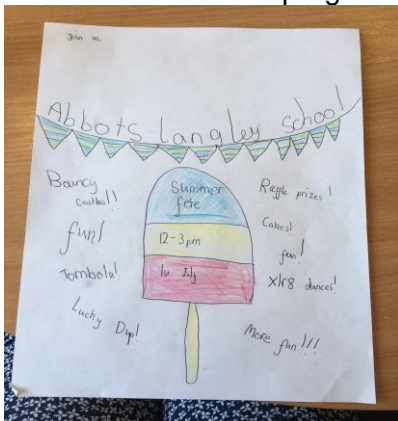
