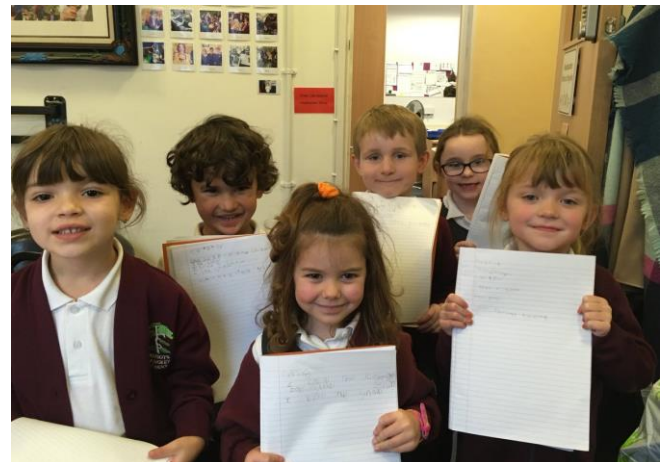

This week we attach details of a local Activity Camp that is running over the Christmas holidays in case this is of interest to parents.

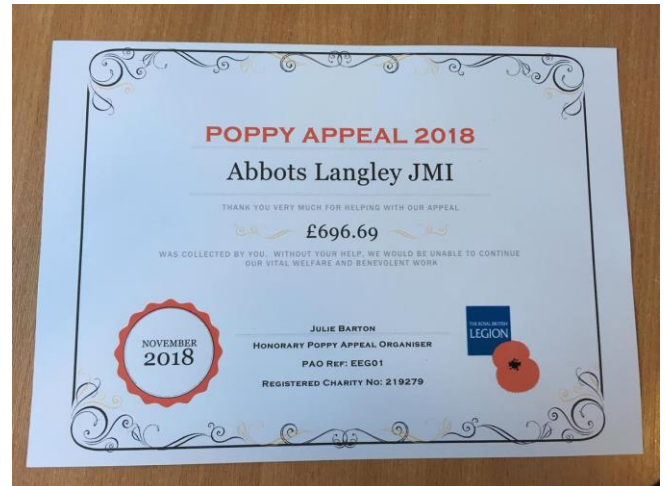
