A reminder to make sure all clothes are named please.

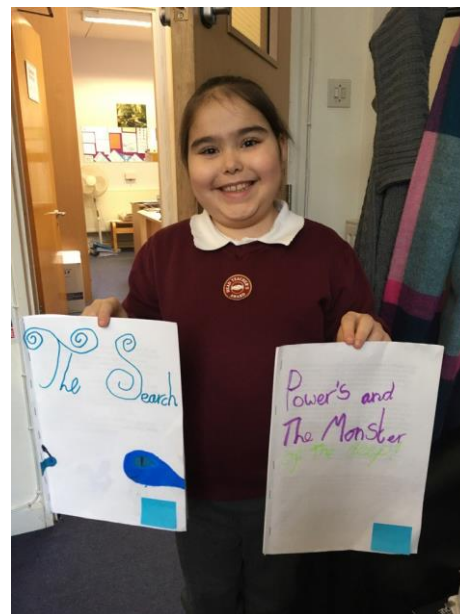
Unauthorised absences and Lateness
